What is Health Technology Assessment?

- **"Health technology"** comprises:
 - medicines,
 - medical devices,
 - in vitro diagnostics devices,
 - medical and surgical procedures, measures for disease prevention, vaccination, treatments - used in healthcare.
- **HTA an evidence-based process that assesses the added value (relative effectiveness)** of a given health technology/health interventions and compares it with other health technologies and / or the current standard of care.

Health Technology Assessment (HTA)

HTA assesses the added value (relative effectiveness) of a given health technology over and above existing ones.



- Offers EU countries the chance to pool expertise



- New proposal for HTA post-2020 presented in January



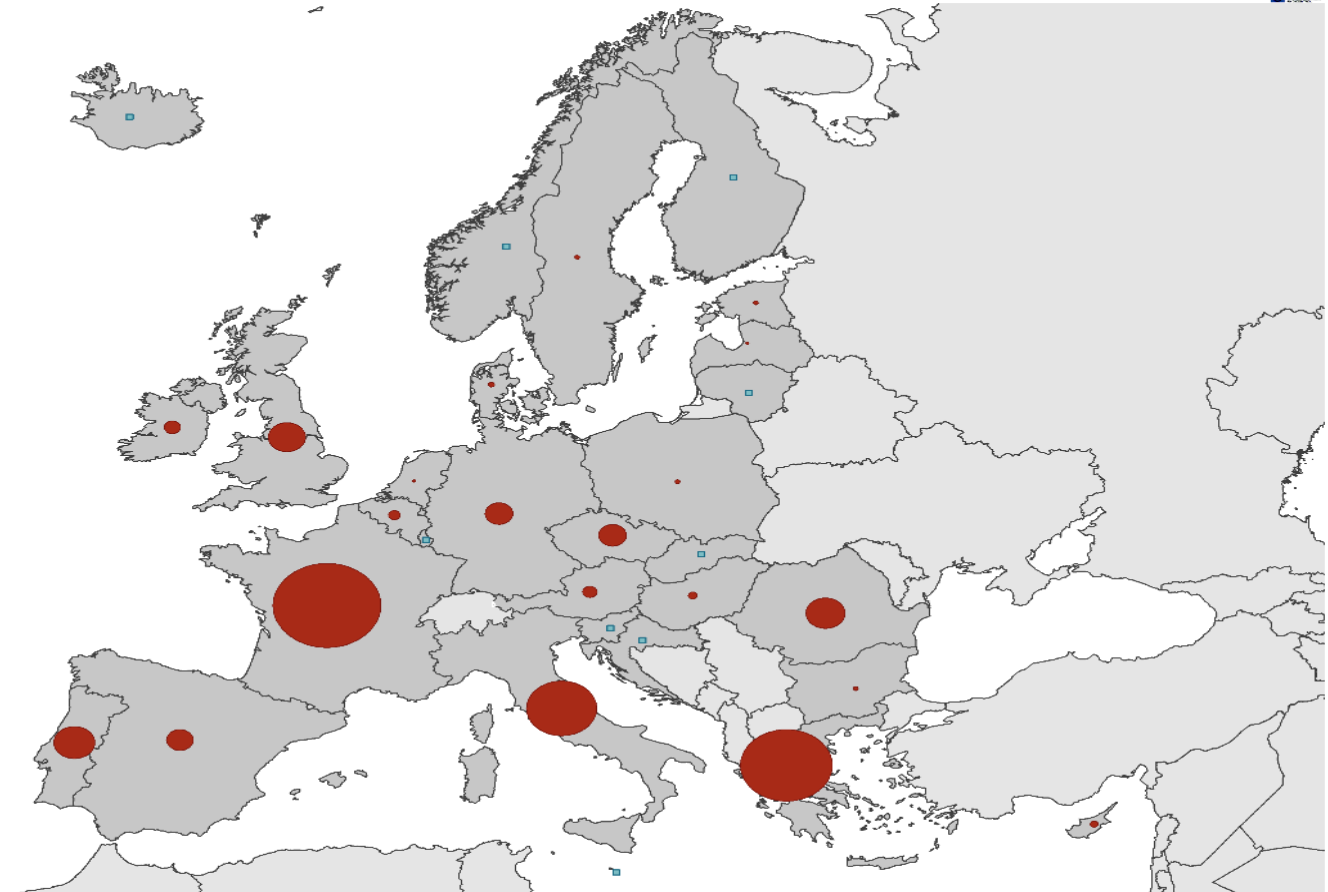
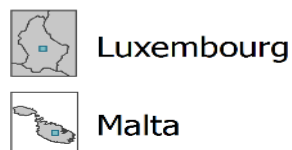
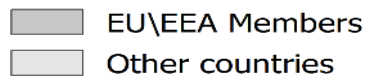
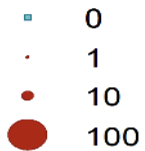

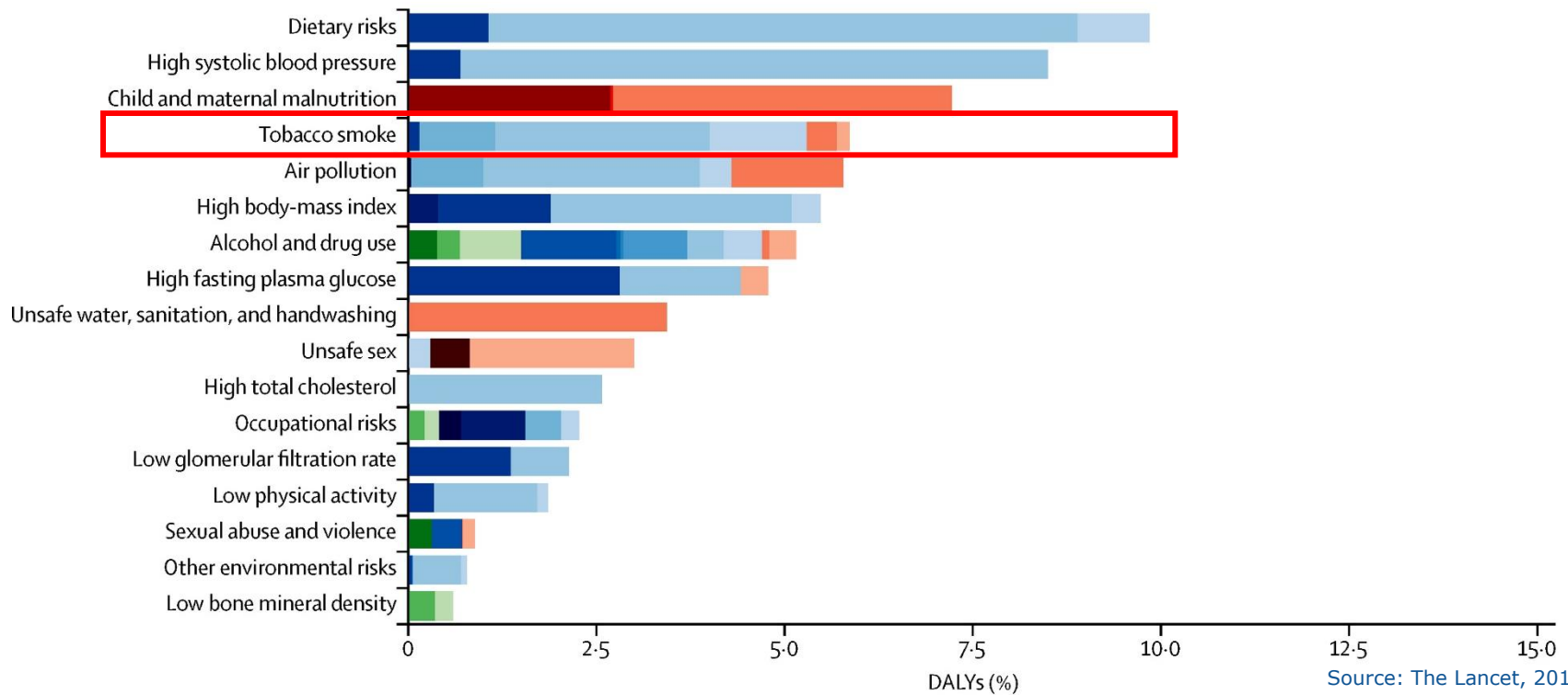

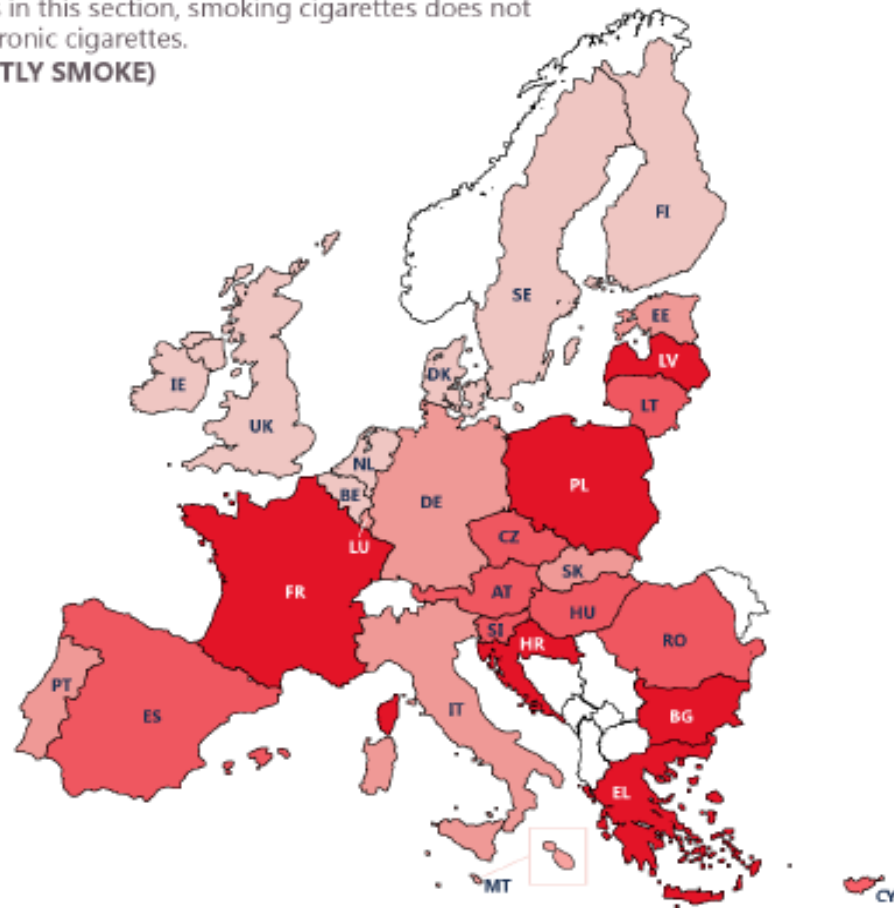
